

SFEMS RECORDER WORKSHOP
SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION AND APPLICATION

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Scholarships will be awarded for any one or a combination of the following factors: financial need, musical merit and promise, desire for personal enrichment, potential benefit to others of applicant's increased knowledge (e.g. through teaching). All else being equal, preference will be given to someone who has not previously attended a summer recorder/early music workshop. We have one full tuition (\$425.00) or two work-study grants (\$325.00), available. If you are a member of the East Bay, Monterey Bay, Sacramento, San Francisco, or South Bay Recorder Society or the American Recorder Society, you should know that scholarships are available from those organizations as well. If you are a member, check with your local ARS chapter to see if it has workshop scholarship assistance available.

Application Procedure: Materials should be completed and mailed by the last week of May. Complete the scholarship application and mail with supporting references to the address above. Recipients will be selected by the SFEMS Recorder Workshop Scholarship Committee. Applicants will be notified by approximately June 1st.
